It is difficult to comprehend that Jarrod has not been with us for the past two years. He was committed and dedicated to improving the lives of children and families living with cancer, and we are proud that we can continue Jarrod's work through this campaign.

In 2019, this initiative began so that we could raise funds for Challenge, in particular Jarrod's Gift which is a program developed to honour Jarrod's memory. Jarrod believed that it was the little things that make a difference to families travelling the cancer journey.
