

Dress Regulations

1. General

Members and Visitors are required to conform to standards of dress both in the clubhouse and on the course. It is the member's responsibility to comply with these standards for themselves and their visitors. As our club is judged by the standards maintained, your co-operation is required.

Any Member of the Board, the General Manager or Professional staff (or any employee so empowered by the General Manager) has the right to refuse entrance into the clubhouse or onto the Golf Course if they deem a member or visitor not suitably attired.

2. Men's General Regulations

a) Shirts

Shirts must be worn at all times and have a "fold over" collar (Mocks permitted). Shirts must be kept "tucked in" to Trousers or shorts except when same are designed for outside wear. Shirts bearing advertising logo or golf motif can be worn providing the logo is within 150cm or pocket size.

b) Trousers and Shorts

Trousers and shorts must be of a tailored standard neat and clean. Shorts must be at or about knee length. Tracksuits, trousers or shorts with a drawstring, and "beach", "football" or "stubby" type shorts are prohibited.

c) Socks

Socks must be worn at all times on the course and when worn with shorts long socks must be pulled up and short socks must be higher than ankle length sport socks. Anklets accepted and must be visible.

d) Shoes

On the course and practice areas all players must wear regulation Golf shoes preferably with soft spikes but metal spikes are allowable.

e) Caps

Caps must be worn in the appropriate manner and with the peak facing forward.

f) Unacceptable

- Tee Shirts
- Singlet, tank tops or beach apparel
- Shirts with large or offensive advertisement or logos
- Board shorts
- Football Jerseys, shorts (including stubby type shorts) and/or socks
- Drawstring shorts
- Training or trackwear
- Overalls
- Dirty or dilapidated wear
- Thongs, plastic type scuffs/slippers or inappropriate footwear

3. Ladies General Regulations

The Board acknowledges that it is not feasible to set down guidelines to cope with the changes in feminine fashion but nevertheless requires that the standard set by and acceptable to the Ladies Committee is adhered to.

a) Tailored Skirts and Shorts (To be no more than 12.5cm above the knee.)

b) Tailored Slacks

c) Shirts or Blouses

Must have either a "fold over" collar or designer round neck (e.g. "mocks"). They must be kept "tucked in", unless specifically designed to be worn outside.

d) Unacceptable

- T Shirts, singlets, tank tops or beach apparel
- Shirts with large or offensive advertisement or logos
- Brief ("Mini") skirts and shorts
- Lycra type shorts or pants
- Training or trackwear
- Tanktops, Sun tops
- Denim Jeans pants/shorts
- Thongs
- No socks with golf shoes
